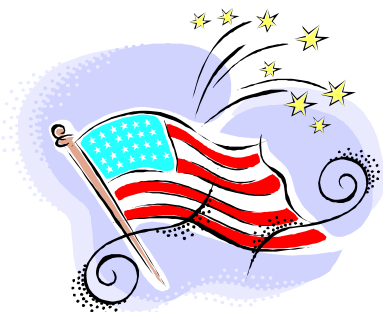
PTSA Meetings are the second Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm in the library. The next meeting will be held on May 8, 2007.
